aberrant	Markedly different from an accepted norm. <i>Aberrant chromosomes.</i>
abnormal	Much greater than the normal. <i>An abnormal interest in food.</i>
alternative	Pertaining to unconventional choices. <i>An alternative lifestyle.</i>
anomalous	Deviating from the general or common order or type. <i>Advanced forms of life may be anomalous in the universe.</i>
atypical	Deviating from normal expectations; somewhat odd, strange, or abnormal. <i>Atypical pneumonia.</i>

curious	Having curiosity aroused; eagerly interested in learning more. <i>Curious investigators.</i>
different	Differing from all others; not ordinary. <i>On two different occasions.</i>
exotic	Being or from or characteristic of another place or part of the world. <i>There was a touch of the exotic in her appearance.</i>
novel	Original and of a kind not seen before. <i>The computer produced a completely novel proof of a well known theorem.</i>
odd	Beyond or deviating from the usual or expected. <i>She looked younger than her fifty odd years.</i>
out of the ordinary	Excluded from use or mention.
peculiar	Belonging exclusively to. <i>Rights peculiar to the rich.</i>
uncommon	Marked by an uncommon quality especially superlative or extreme of its kind. <i>An uncommon name.</i>
unconventional	Not conforming to legality, moral law, or social convention. <i>Unconventional life styles.</i>
unorthodox	Breaking with convention or tradition. <i>He frequently upset other scholars with his unorthodox views.</i>
unusual	Not commonly encountered. <i>A man of unusual talent.</i>
unwonted	Unaccustomed or unusual. <i>There was an unwonted gaiety in her manner.</i>
