<b>unconstrained</b>	Not restricted or limited. <i><b>Unconstrained</b> growth.</i>
<b>uncontrollable</b>	Impossible to repress or control. <i><b>Uncontrollable</b> children.</i>
<b>uncontrolled</b>	Not controlled. <i>In mice the growth was <b>uncontrolled</b> and resembled cancer.</i>
<b>uncurbed</b>	Not restrained or controlled. <i>Their activities continue to be largely <b>uncurbed</b>.</i>
<b>undisciplined</b>	Not subjected to discipline. <i>The paintings were the work of an <b>undisciplined</b> talent.</i>
<b>unfettered</b>	Unrestrained or uninhibited. <i><b>Unfettered</b> artistic genius.</i>
<b>ungoverned</b>	Not restrained or controlled. <i>The fatal end of an <b>ungoverned</b> passion.</i>
<b>unhampered</b>	Not impeded or encumbered. <i>A priest <b>unhampered</b> by scruple.</i>
<b>unimpeded</b>	Not slowed or prevented. <i>An <b>unimpeded</b> view across the headland.</i>
<b>uninhibited</b>	Expressing one's feelings or thoughts unselfconsciously and without restraint. <i><b>Uninhibited</b> exuberance.</i>
<b>unlimited</b>	Without reservation or exception. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not <b>unlimited</b>.</i>
<b>unrestricted</b>	Not restricted or exclusive. <i><b>Unrestricted</b> access to both military bases.</i>
<b>unshackled</b>	Not bound by shackles and chains. <i>He had handcuffs on his wrists but his feet were <b>unshackled</b>.</i>
<b>unsuppressed</b>	Not restrained or repressed. <i><b>Unsuppressed</b> rage.</i>
<b>untrammelled</b>	Not confined or limited. <i>A mind <b>untrammelled</b> by convention.</i>

<b>changeless</b>	Remaining the same for indefinitely long times. <i><b>Changeless</b> truths.</i>
<b>constant</b>	A number representing a quantity assumed to have a fixed value in a specified mathematical context. <i>In <b>constant</b> pain.</i>
<b>continually</b>	Seemingly without interruption. <i>This information is <b>continually</b> updated.</i>
<b>continue</b>	Continue a certain state condition or activity. <i>They have indicated their willingness to <b>continue</b> in office.</i>
<b>continuously</b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>These images loop <b>continuously</b>.</i>
<b>endless</b>	Having no known beginning and presumably no end. <i><b>Endless</b> debates.</i>
<b>eternal</b>	Used to refer to an everlasting or universal spirit, as represented by God. <i>Fear of <b>eternal</b> damnation.</i>
<b>ever</b>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>They felt better than <b>ever</b> before.</i>
<b>forever</b>	Continually. <i>These puppies need a <b>forever</b> home.</i>
<b>grinding</b>	Material resulting from the process of grinding. <i>The roasting and <b>grinding</b> of grain usually barley for use in brewing.</i>
<b>illimitable</b>	Without limits or an end. <i>The <b>illimitable</b> human capacity for evil.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	(of something regarded as unpleasant) continuing without pause or interruption. <i>Night and day we live with the <b>incessant</b> noise of the city.</i>
<b>incessantly</b>	Without interruption; constantly. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>indefinitely</b>	To an indefinite extent; for an indefinite time. <i>An <b>indefinitely</b> large number of channels.</i>

<b><u>infinite</u></b>	A space or quantity that is infinite. <i><b>Infinite</b> wealth.</i>
<b>interminable</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>An <b>interminable</b> sermon.</i>
<b><u>limitless</u></b>	Having no limits in range or scope. <i>Our resources are not <b>limitless</b>.</i>
<b>measureless</b>	Without limits in extent or size or quantity. <i>Otto had <b>measureless</b> charm.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	Never ending or changing. <i>Hell s <b>perpetual</b> fires.</i>
<b><u>perpetuity</u></b>	A restriction making an interest in land inalienable perpetually or for a period beyond certain limits fixed by law. <i>He did not believe in the <b>perpetuity</b> of military rule.</i>
<b><u>unbounded</u></b>	Having or appearing to have no limits. <i>The possibilities are <b>unbounded</b>.</i>
<b><u>unbridled</u></b>	Uncontrolled; unconstrained. <i>A moment of <b>unbridled</b> ambition.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Man s <b>unceasing</b> warfare with drought and isolation.</i>
<b>unceasingly</b>	With unflagging resolve.
<b>unfettered</b>	Unrestrained or uninhibited. <i><b>Unfettered</b> artistic genius.</i>
<b><u>uninhibited</u></b>	Not inhibited or restrained. <i>Fits of <b>uninhibited</b> laughter.</i>
<b>unlimited</b>	Without reservation or exception. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not <b>unlimited</b>.</i>
<b><u>unrestrained</u></b>	Not subject to restraint. <i>A display of <b>unrestrained</b> delight.</i>
