unassuming Not arrogant or presuming.

Unassuming to a fault skeptical about the value of his work.

unpresuming Modest; unassuming.

A quiet **unpresuming** man.

Withdrawn from society seeking solitude.

withdrawn When her husband died she became very withdrawn.
