### Synonyms of "Unconfident" as an adjective (16 Words)

<b>bashful</b>	Disposed to avoid notice blate is a Scottish term for bashful. <i>Everything you need to know but have been too <b>bashful</b> to ask.</i>
<b>humble</b>	(of a thing) of modest pretensions or dimensions. <i>Of <b>humble</b> or lowly birth.</i>
<b>inhibited</b>	Held back or restrained or prevented. <i>In certain conditions previously <b>inhibited</b> conditioned reactions can reappear.</i>
<b>introverted</b>	Given to examining own sensory and perceptual experiences.
<a href="#">meek</a>	Very docile- Langston Hughes. <i>She brought her <b>meek</b> little husband along.</i>

<b><u>modest</u></b>	Humble in spirit or manner; suggesting retiring mildness or even cowed submissiveness. <i><b>Modest</b> inflation.</i>
<b><u>reserved</u></b>	Kept specially for a particular person. <i>He is a <b>reserved</b> almost taciturn man.</i>
<b>self-effacing</b>	Reluctant to draw attention to yourself.
<b>shrinking</b>	Becoming smaller in size or amount. <i>The <b>shrinking</b> market has provoked a massive price war.</i>
<b>shy</b>	Short. <i>He left school just <b>shy</b> of his fourteenth birthday.</i>
<b><u>timid</u></b>	Lacking conviction or boldness or courage. <i>Problems that call for bold not <b>timid</b> responses.</i>
<b>timorous</b>	Showing or suffering from nervousness or a lack of confidence. <i><b>Timorous</b> little mouse.</i>
<b>unassertive</b>	Inclined to timidity or lack of self-confidence. <i>His bland and <b>unassertive</b> personal style.</i>
<b><u>unassuming</u></b>	Not arrogant or presuming. <i><b>Unassuming</b> to a fault skeptical about the value of his work.</i>
<b>unpresuming</b>	Modest; unassuming. <i>A quiet <b>unpresuming</b> man.</i>
<b><u>withdrawn</u></b>	Withdrawn from society seeking solitude. <i>When her husband died she became very <b>withdrawn</b>.</i>
