Synonyms of "Unconfident" as an adjective (16 Words)

bashful	Disposed to avoid notice blate is a Scottish term for bashful. <i>Everything you need to know but have been too bashful to ask.</i>
humble	(of a thing) of modest pretensions or dimensions. <i>Of humble or lowly birth.</i>
inhibited	Held back or restrained or prevented. <i>In certain conditions previously inhibited conditioned reactions can reappear.</i>
introverted	Given to examining own sensory and perceptual experiences.
<u>meek</u>	Very docile- Langston Hughes. <i>She brought her meek little husband along.</i>

<u>modest</u>	Humble in spirit or manner; suggesting retiring mildness or even cowed submissiveness. <i>Modest inflation.</i>
<u>reserved</u>	Kept specially for a particular person. <i>He is a reserved almost taciturn man.</i>
self-effacing	Reluctant to draw attention to yourself.
shrinking	Becoming smaller in size or amount. <i>The shrinking market has provoked a massive price war.</i>
shy	Short. <i>He left school just shy of his fourteenth birthday.</i>
<u>timid</u>	Lacking conviction or boldness or courage. <i>Problems that call for bold not timid responses.</i>
timorous	Showing or suffering from nervousness or a lack of confidence. <i>Timorous little mouse.</i>
unassertive	Inclined to timidity or lack of self-confidence. <i>His bland and unassertive personal style.</i>
<u>unassuming</u>	Not arrogant or presuming. <i>Unassuming to a fault skeptical about the value of his work.</i>
unpresuming	Modest; unassuming. <i>A quiet unpresuming man.</i>
<u>withdrawn</u>	Withdrawn from society seeking solitude. <i>When her husband died she became very withdrawn.</i>

Usage Examples of "Unconfident" as an adjective

- *Very young people may have an unconfident approach.*
- *The airmen were young, but not unconfident.*
