- *Not in accordance with the political constitution or with procedural rules.*
- *Not consistent with or according to a constitution; contrary to the U.S. Constitution.*

### Synonyms of "Unconstitutional" as an adjective (11 Words)

<b><a href="#">absolute</a></b>	(of powers or rights) not subject to any limitation; unconditional. <i>The decree of nullity was made <b>absolute</b>.</i>
<b>absolutist</b>	Relating to or supporting absolute principles. <i>These claims might strike many people as <b>absolutist</b> and extreme.</i>
<b><a href="#">arbitrary</a></b>	(of power or a ruling body) unrestrained and autocratic in the use of authority. <i>An <b>arbitrary</b> choice.</i>
<b>authoritarian</b>	Expecting unquestioning obedience. <i>He had an <b>authoritarian</b> and at times belligerent manner.</i>
<b>autocratic</b>	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. <i><b>Autocratic</b> government.</i>

<b>dictatorial</b>	Of or typical of a ruler with total power. <i>A <b>dictatorial</b> rule that lasted for the duration of the war.</i>
<b>summary</b>	Not including needless details or formalities; brief. <i>A <b>summary</b> formulation of a wide ranging subject.</i>
<b>totalitarian</b>	Of or relating to the principles of totalitarianism according to which the state regulates every realm of life. <i>A <b>totalitarian</b> regime.</i>
<b>unaccountable</b>	Not to be accounted for or explained. <i>He was not only the most charismatic man she d ever met but also the most complex and <b>unaccountable</b>.</i>
<b><u>uncontrolled</u></b>	Not being under control; out of control. <i>The greatest <b>uncontrolled</b> health problem is AIDS.</i>
<b><u>undemocratic</u></b>	Not relating or according to democratic principles. <i>The union broke with its past <b>undemocratic</b> procedures.</i>
