- Not in accordance with the political constitution or with procedural rules.
- *Not consistent with or according to a constitution; contrary to the U.S. Constitution.*

## Synonyms of "Unconstitutional" as an adjective (11 Words)

**absolutist** Relating to or supporting absolute principles.

authoritarian Expecting unquestioning obedience.

**autocratic** Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power.

Autocratic government.



**dictatorial** Of or typical of a ruler with total power.

A **dictatorial** rule that lasted for the duration of the war.

summary Not including needless details or formalities; brief.

A **summary** formulation of a wide ranging subject.

Of or relating to the principles of totalitarianism according to which the

**totalitarian** state regulates every realm of life.

A totalitarian regime.

Not to be accounted for or explained.

**unaccountable** He was not only the most charismatic man she d ever met but also the

most complex and unaccountable.

uncontrolled Not being under control; out of control.

The greatest **uncontrolled** health problem is AIDS.

undemocratic Not relating or according to democratic principles.

The union broke with its past **undemocratic** procedures.
