Synonyms of "Uncontrolled" as an adjective (24 Words)

immoderate	Not sensible or restrained; excessive. <i>Immoderate</i> laughter.
incontinent	Not having control over urination and defecation. Elderly incontinent parents.
intemperate	(of weather or climate) not mild; subject to extremes. An intemperate social occasion.
out of control	No longer fashionable.
out of hand	Outer or outlying.
<u>rampant</u>	Rearing on left hind leg with forelegs elevated and head usually in profile. <i>Rampant sex.</i>
runaway	Completely out of control. <i>Runaway</i> inflation.
<u>unbounded</u>	Having or appearing to have no limits. <i>The possibilities are unbounded</i> .
<u>unbridled</u>	Uncontrolled; unconstrained. Unbridled rage.
<u>unchecked</u>	(especially of something undesirable) not controlled or restrained. The broadcast was sloppy it was unchecked there was no investigation of the facts.
unconfined	Free from confinement or physical restraint. Sows should be unconfined at farrowing.



unconstrained	Not restricted or limited. <i>Idle unconstrained</i> gossip.
uncurbed	Not restrained or controlled. Their activities continue to be largely uncurbed .
undisciplined	Lacking in discipline or control. Undisciplined talent.
unfettered	Unrestrained or uninhibited. Unfettered artistic genius.
unhampered	Not impeded or encumbered. <i>This would give black people the opportunity to live unhampered by</i> <i>racism.</i>
<u>unimpeded</u>	Not obstructed or hindered. An unimpeded view across the headland.
<u>uninhibited</u>	Not having been restrained or suppressed. A lively and uninhibited girl.
unlimited	Having no limits in range or scope- Philip Rahv. Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not unlimited .
<u>unrestrained</u>	Not restrained or restricted. A display of unrestrained delight.
unrestricted	Not restricted or modified in meaning. Unrestricted access to both military bases.
unsuppressed	Not restrained or repressed. Unsuppressed feelings.
untrammelled	Not deprived of freedom of action or expression; not restricted or hampered. <i>A mind untrammelled by convention.</i>
wild	Produced from wild animals or plants without cultivation. Who even in their wild est dreams could have anticipated such a victory.

- The greatest uncontrolled health problem is AIDS.
- Some uncontrolled children rather marred the proceedings.
