## Synonyms of "Uncontrolled" as an adjective (24 Words)

<b>immoderate</b>	Not sensible or restrained; excessive. <i>Immoderate</i> laughter.
<b>incontinent</b>	Not having control over urination and defecation. Elderly <i>incontinent</i> parents.
<b>intemperate</b>	(of weather or climate) not mild; subject to extremes. An <i>intemperate</i> social occasion.
<b>out of control</b>	No longer fashionable.
<b>out of hand</b>	Outer or outlying.
<b>rampant</b>	Rearing on left hind leg with forelegs elevated and head usually in profile. <i>Rampant</i> sex.
<b>runaway</b>	Completely out of control. <i>Runaway</i> inflation.
<b>unbounded</b>	Having or appearing to have no limits. The possibilities are <i>unbounded</i> .
<b>unbridled</b>	Uncontrolled; unconstrained. <i>Unbridled</i> rage.
<b>unchecked</b>	(especially of something undesirable) not controlled or restrained. The broadcast was sloppy it was <i>unchecked</i> there was no investigation of the facts.
<b>unconfined</b>	Free from confinement or physical restraint. Sows should be <i>unconfined</i> at farrowing.

<b>unconstrained</b>	Not restricted or limited. <i>Idle <b>unconstrained</b> gossip.</i>
<b>uncurbed</b>	Not restrained or controlled. <i>Their activities continue to be largely <b>uncurbed</b>.</i>
<b>undisciplined</b>	Lacking in discipline or control. <i><b>Undisciplined</b> talent.</i>
<b>unfettered</b>	Unrestrained or uninhibited. <i><b>Unfettered</b> artistic genius.</i>
<b>unhampered</b>	Not impeded or encumbered. <i>This would give black people the opportunity to live <b>unhampered</b> by racism.</i>
<b><u>unimpeded</u></b>	Not obstructed or hindered. <i>An <b>unimpeded</b> view across the headland.</i>
<b><u>uninhibited</u></b>	Not having been restrained or suppressed. <i>A lively and <b>uninhibited</b> girl.</i>
<b>unlimited</b>	Having no limits in range or scope- Philip Rahv. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not <b>unlimited</b>.</i>
<b><u>unrestrained</u></b>	Not restrained or restricted. <i>A display of <b>unrestrained</b> delight.</i>
<b>unrestricted</b>	Not restricted or modified in meaning. <i><b>Unrestricted</b> access to both military bases.</i>
<b>unsuppressed</b>	Not restrained or repressed. <i><b>Unsuppressed</b> feelings.</i>
<b>untrammelled</b>	Not deprived of freedom of action or expression; not restricted or hampered. <i>A mind <b>untrammelled</b> by convention.</i>
<b>wild</b>	Produced from wild animals or plants without cultivation. <i>Who even in their <b>wildest</b> dreams could have anticipated such a victory.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Uncontrolled" as an adjective

- *Uncontrolled growth.*
- *In mice, the growth was uncontrolled and resembled cancer.*
- *The greatest uncontrolled health problem is AIDS.*
- *Some uncontrolled children rather marred the proceedings.*
