## Uncountable as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Uncountable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “uncountable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Too many to be counted (usually in hyperbolic use).*
- *(of a noun) that cannot form a plural or be used with the indefinite article.*

### Synonyms of "Uncountable" as an adjective (5 Words)

<b><u>immeasurable</u></b>	Impossible to measure. <i>Immeasurable suffering.</i>
<b>incomputable</b>	Beyond calculation or measure. <i>An <b>incomputable</b> amount.</i>
<b>indeterminable</b>	(of a dispute or difficulty) not able to be resolved. <i>A woman of <b>indeterminable</b> age.</i>
<b>inestimable</b>	Beyond calculation or measure. <i>A treasure of <b>inestimable</b> value.</i>
<b>untold</b>	Too much to be measured. <i>No event however boring is left <b>untold</b>.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Uncountable" as an adjective

- *'courage' and 'information' are uncountable nouns.*
- *She'd spent uncountable nights in this very bed.*
