Uncountable as an Adjective

Definitions of "Uncountable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “uncountable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Too many to be counted (usually in hyperbolic use.*
- *(of a noun) that cannot form a plural or be used with the indefinite article.*

Synonyms of "Uncountable" as an adjective (5 Words)

<u>immeasurable</u>	Impossible to measure. <i>Immeasurable suffering.</i>
incomputable	Beyond calculation or measure. <i>An incomputable amount.</i>
indeterminable	(of a dispute or difficulty) not able to be resolved. <i>A woman of indeterminable age.</i>
inestimable	Beyond calculation or measure. <i>A treasure of inestimable value.</i>
untold	Too much to be measured. <i>No event however boring is left untold.</i>

Usage Examples of "Uncountable" as an adjective

- *'courage' and 'information' are uncountable nouns.*
- *She'd spent uncountable nights in this very bed.*
