- Too many to be counted (usually in hyperbolic use.
- (of a noun) that cannot form a plural or be used with the indefinite article.

Synonyms of "Uncountable" as an adjective (5 Words)

immeasurable Impossible to measure.

Immeasurable suffering.

incomputable Beyond calculation or measure.

An **incomputable** amount.

indeterminable (of a dispute or difficulty) not able to be resolved.

A woman of **indeterminable** age.

inestimable Beyond calculation or measure.

A treasure of **inestimable** value.

untold Too much to be measured.

No event however boring is left untold.



Usage Examples of "Uncountable" as an adjective

- 'courage' and 'information' are uncountable nouns.
