Synonyms of "Undefined" as an adjective (22 Words)

bleary	(of the eyes) looking or feeling dull and unfocused from sleep or tiredness. <i>Boris opened a bleary eye.</i>
blurred	Unclear in form or expression- H.G.Wells. <i>The camera caught only two blurred images.</i>
blurry	Indistinct or hazy in outline. <i>Their eyes were blurry with tears.</i>
dim	Made dim or less bright. <i>The dimmed houselights brought a hush of anticipation.</i>
formless	Having no physical form. <i>Belief in a world filled with formless but often malevolent beings.</i>
hazy	Indistinct or hazy in outline. <i>The picture we have of him is extremely hazy.</i>

indefinite	Not clearly expressed or defined; vague. <i>In Greek the dual contrasts with the indefinite plural.</i>
indeterminate	(of a shoot) not having all the axes terminating in a flower bud and so potentially of indefinite length. <i>An indeterminate campaign.</i>
indistinct	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i>Indistinct shapes in the gloom.</i>
indistinguishable	Not able to be identified as different or distinct. <i>The counterfeit bills were virtually indistinguishable from the real thing.</i>
misty	Indistinct or dim in outline. <i>It was their last night and Ruth turned her misty eyes to Fernando.</i>
nebulous	In the form of a cloud or haze; hazy. <i>Nebulous concepts like quality of life.</i>
obscure	Not clearly understood or expressed-Anatole Broyard- P.A.So. <i>Those who do not appreciate Kafka s work say his style is obscure.</i>
out of focus	No longer fashionable.
shadowy	Lacking in substance- W.A.Butler. <i>A shadowy figure appeared through the mist.</i>
undetermined	Not known. <i>Of undetermined species.</i>
unexplained	Having the reason or cause not made clear. <i>Cot death is still an unexplained phenomenon.</i>
unfixed	Lacking definition or definite content- Jane Austen. <i>The green cloth cover had become unfixed in a dozen places.</i>
unsettled	Lacking order or stability. <i>They charge interest on debts that remain unsettled after 30 days.</i>
unspecific	Not specific; vague. <i>Felt an unspecific dread.</i>
unspecified	Not stated clearly or exactly. <i>An unspecified number of people.</i>
vague	Not precisely limited, determined, or distinguished. <i>He had been very vague about his activities.</i>
