## Synonyms of "Undefined" as an adjective (22 Words)

<b>bleary</b>	(of the eyes) looking or feeling dull and unfocused from sleep or tiredness. <i>Boris opened a <b>bleary</b> eye.</i>
<b>blurred</b>	Unclear in form or expression- H.G.Wells. <i>The camera caught only two <b>blurred</b> images.</i>
<u><a href="#">blurry</a></u>	Indistinct or hazy in outline. <i>Their eyes were <b>blurry</b> with tears.</i>
<u><a href="#">dim</a></u>	Made dim or less bright. <i>The <b>dimmed</b> houselights brought a hush of anticipation.</i>
<b>formless</b>	Having no physical form. <i>Belief in a world filled with <b>formless</b> but often malevolent beings.</i>
<u><a href="#">hazy</a></u>	Indistinct or hazy in outline. <i>The picture we have of him is extremely <b>hazy</b>.</i>

<b>indefinite</b>	Not clearly expressed or defined; vague. <i>In Greek the dual contrasts with the <b>indefinite</b> plural.</i>
<b>indeterminate</b>	(of a shoot) not having all the axes terminating in a flower bud and so potentially of indefinite length. <i>An <b>indeterminate</b> campaign.</i>
<b>indistinct</b>	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i><b>Indistinct</b> shapes in the gloom.</i>
<b>indistinguishable</b>	Not able to be identified as different or distinct. <i>The counterfeit bills were virtually <b>indistinguishable</b> from the real thing.</i>
<b>misty</b>	Indistinct or dim in outline. <i>It was their last night and Ruth turned her <b>misty</b> eyes to Fernando.</i>
<b>nebulous</b>	In the form of a cloud or haze; hazy. <i><b>Nebulous</b> concepts like quality of life.</i>
<b>obscure</b>	Not clearly understood or expressed-Anatole Broyard- P.A.So. <i>Those who do not appreciate Kafka s work say his style is <b>obscure</b>.</i>
<b>out of focus</b>	No longer fashionable.
<b>shadowy</b>	Lacking in substance- W.A.Butler. <i>A <b>shadowy</b> figure appeared through the mist.</i>
<b>undetermined</b>	Not known. <i>Of <b>undetermined</b> species.</i>
<b>unexplained</b>	Having the reason or cause not made clear. <i>Cot death is still an <b>unexplained</b> phenomenon.</i>
<b>unfixed</b>	Lacking definition or definite content- Jane Austen. <i>The green cloth cover had become <b>unfixed</b> in a dozen places.</i>
<b>unsettled</b>	Lacking order or stability. <i>They charge interest on debts that remain <b>unsettled</b> after 30 days.</i>
<b>unspecific</b>	Not specific; vague. <i>Felt an <b>unspecific</b> dread.</i>
<b>unspecified</b>	Not stated clearly or exactly. <i>An <b>unspecified</b> number of people.</i>
<b>vague</b>	Not precisely limited, determined, or distinguished. <i>He had been very <b>vague</b> about his activities.</i>
