- Not in agreement with or according to democratic doctrine or practice or ideals.

Synonyms of "Undemocratic" as an adjective (12 Words)

absolute (of an adjective) used without an expressed noun (e.g. the brave).

An **absolute** dimwit.

Based on or subject to individual discretion or preference or sometimes

arbitrary impulse or caprice.

The **arbitrary** rule of a dictator.

autarchic Of or relating to or characterized by autarchy.

autocratic Taking no account of other people's wishes or opinions; domineering.

Autocratic behavior.

despotic Belonging to or having the characteristics of a despot.

Despotic rulers.



dictatorial Expecting unquestioning obedience.

A dictatorial regime.

(of laws or their application) excessively harsh and severe.

draconian The Nazis destroyed the independence of the press by a series of **draconian**

laws.

Opposed to liberal principles; restricting freedom of thought or behaviour.

Illiberal and anti democratic policies.

oppressive Inflicting harsh and authoritarian treatment.

The day was sunless and **oppressive**.

repressive Inhibiting or preventing the expression or awareness of thoughts or desires.

A **repressive** moral code.

Of or relating to the principles of totalitarianism according to which the state

totalitarian regulates every realm of life.

Totalitarian theory and practice.

tyrannical Exercising power in a cruel or arbitrary way.

A **tyrannical** parent.
