Definitions of "Undeniable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “undeniable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not possible to deny.*
- *Unable to be denied or disputed.*

Synonyms of "Undeniable" as an adjective (9 Words)

inarguable	Against which no argument can be made.
incontestable	Incapable of being contested or disputed.
incontrovertible	Impossible to deny or disprove. <i>Incontrovertible proof of the defendant s innocence.</i>
indisputable	Unable to be challenged or denied. <i>Indisputable or sure proof.</i>
indubitable	Impossible to doubt; unquestionable. <i>An indubitable truth.</i>
irrefutable	Impossible to deny or disprove. <i>An irrefutable argument.</i>
<u>unassailable</u>	Immune to attack; incapable of being tampered with. <i>An unassailable lead.</i>

undebatable

Not open to discussion or argument.

The **undebatable** effectiveness of learning by doing.

unquestionable

Not open to question.

An **unquestionable** antique.
