Underexaggerate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **underexaggerate** We **underexaggerate**
You **underexaggerate** You **underexaggerate**
He/She/It **underexaggerates** They **underexaggerate**

Underexaggerate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am underexaggerating** We **are underexaggerating**
You **are underexaggerating** You **are underexaggerating**
He/She/It **is underexaggerating** They **are underexaggerating**

Underexaggerate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have underexaggerated** We **have underexaggerated**
You **have underexaggerated** You **have underexaggerated**
He/She/It **has underexaggerated** They **have underexaggerated**

I had underexaggerated We had underexaggerated
You had underexaggerated You had underexaggerated
He/She/It had underexaggerated They had underexaggerated

I had been underexaggerating We had been underexaggerating
You had been underexaggerating You had been underexaggerating
He/She/It had been underexaggerating They had been underexaggerating

I will underexaggerate We will underexaggerate
You will underexaggerate You will underexaggerate
He/She/It will underexaggerate They will underexaggerate

Underexaggerate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be underexaggerating We will be underexaggerating
You will be underexaggerating You will be underexaggerating
He/She/It will be underexaggerating They will be underexaggerating

Underexaggerate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have underexaggerated

We will have underexaggerated

You will have underexaggerated

You will have underexaggerated

He/She/It will have underexaggerated **They will have underexaggerated**

I will have been underexaggerating

We will have been underexaggerating

You will have been underexaggerating

You will have been underexaggerating

He/She/It will have been underexaggerating **They will have been underexaggerating**
