**Underrun in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **underrun**                      We **underrun**  
You **underrun**                You **underrun**  
He/She/It **underruns**    They **underrun**

**Underrun in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am underrunning**            We **are underrunning**  
You **are underrunning**        You **are underrunning**  
He/She/It **is underrunning**    They **are underrunning**

**Underrun in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have underrun**                We **have underrun**  
You **have underrun**            You **have underrun**  
He/She/It **has underrun**    They **have underrun**

**Underrun in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been underrunning**        We **have been underrunning**  
You **have been underrunning**      You **have been underrunning**  
He/She/It **has been underrunning**    They **have been underrunning**

**Underrun in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **underran**                      We **underran**  
You **underran**                You **underran**  
He/She/It **underran**        They **underran**

**Underrun in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was underrunning      We were underrunning  
You were underrunning      You were underrunning  
He/She/It was underrunning      They were underrunning

**Underrun in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had underrun      We had underrun  
You had underrun      You had underrun  
He/She/It had underrun      They had underrun

**Underrun in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been underrunning      We had been underrunning  
You had been underrunning      You had been underrunning  
He/She/It had been underrunning      They had been underrunning

**Underrun in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will underrun      We will underrun  
You will underrun      You will underrun  
He/She/It will underrun      They will underrun

**Underrun in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be underrunning      We will be underrunning  
You will be underrunning      You will be underrunning  
He/She/It will be underrunning      They will be underrunning

**Underrun in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have underrun**

**We will have underrun**

**You will have underrun**

**You will have underrun**

**He/She/It will have underrun** **They will have underrun**

**Underrun in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been underrunning**

**We will have been underrunning**

**You will have been underrunning**

**You will have been underrunning**

**He/She/It will have been underrunning** **They will have been underrunning**
