Infinitive	to understand
Present Tense	understand / understands
Past Tense	understood
Present Participle	understanding
Past Participle	understood

# **Conjugate Understand**

## **Understand in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I understand	We <b>understand</b>
You <b>understand</b>	You <b>understand</b>
He/She/It understands	They <b>understand</b>

## **Understand in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am understanding	We are understanding
You <b>are understanding</b>	You are understanding
He/She/It is understanding	They are understanding

#### **Understand in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have understood	We have understood
You have understood	You have understood
He/She/It has understood	They have understood

### **Understand in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been understanding	We have been understanding
You <b>have been understanding</b>	You have been understanding
He/She/It has been understanding	They have been understanding

## **Understand in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I understood	We <b>understood</b>
You <b>understood</b>	You <b>understood</b>
He/She/It <b>understood</b>	They <b>understood</b>

#### **Understand in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was understanding	We were understanding
You were understanding	You were understanding
He/She/It was understanding	They were understanding

#### **Understand in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had understood	We had understood
You had understood	You had understood
He/She/It had understood	They had understood

#### **Understand in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been understanding	We had been understanding
You <b>had been understanding</b>	You <b>had been understanding</b>
He/She/It had been understanding	They had been understanding

## **Understand in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will understand	We will understand
You <b>will understand</b>	You <b>will understand</b>
He/She/It will understand	They will understand

## **Understand in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be understanding	We <b>will be understanding</b>
You <b>will be understanding</b>	You will be understanding
He/She/It will be understanding	They will be understanding

#### **Understand in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have understoodWe will have understoodYou will have understoodYou will have understoodHe/She/It will have understoodThey will have understood

## **Understand in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been understanding	We will have been understanding
You <b>will have been understanding</b>	You <b>will have been understanding</b>
He/She/It will have been understanding	They will have been understanding
