anonymous	Having no known name or identity or known source. An anonymous gift.
<u>blind</u>	Make blind by putting the eyes out. The injury temporarily blind ed him.
esoteric	Confined to and understandable by only an enlightened inner circle. <i>A compilation of esoteric philosophical theories.</i>
inglorious	(used of conduct or character) deserving or bringing disgrace or shame. Inglorious though the peasants may have been this is not synonymous with mute.
<u>invisible</u>	Invisible exports and imports. <i>Invisible</i> rays.
nameless	Having no name or no known name. A nameless yearning for transcendence.
<u>neglect</u>	The trait of neglecting responsibilities and lacking concern. The old churchyard has been sadly neglect ed.
<u>obscure</u>	Make obscure or unclear. The big elm tree obscure s our view of the valley.
<u>occult</u>	(of a celestial body) conceal (an apparently smaller body) from view by passing or being in front of it. Occult lore.
offstage	(in a theatre) not taking place on the stage and so not visible to the audience. <i>Screams were heard offstage</i> .
recondite	Difficult to penetrate; incomprehensible to one of ordinary understanding or knowledge. Some recondite problem in historiography.
<u>remaining</u>	Still to happen; future. They advertised for any remaining creditors to come forward.



<u>shameful</u>	Giving offense to moral sensibilities and injurious to reputation. The wicked rascally shameful conduct of the bankrupt.
sight	Take a detailed visual measurement of something with or as with a sight. <i>The train was an unexpected</i> sight .
soundproof	Preventing, or constructed of material that prevents, the passage of sound. A soundproof windowless room.
<u>survivor</u>	The remainder of a group of people or things. <i>She is a born survivor.</i>
<u>unappreciated</u>	Not likely to be rewarded. She had been brought up in a family where she felt unappreciated and undervalued.
<u>unaware</u>	(often followed by `of') not aware. Unaware of the danger they were in.
undiagnosed	Eluding diagnosis. Some patients have diseases that go undiagnosed and therefore untreated.
undiscovered	Not discovered. The novel had lain undiscovered for years among his papers.
<u>unfamiliar</u>	Unusual or uncharacteristic. He felt a stranger among the crowd of unfamiliar faces.
unidentified	Being or having an unknown or unnamed source. A picture of an unidentified motorcyclist.
<u>unintentionally</u>	Not on purpose. I may have unintentionally misled some of you.
unknown	Being or having an unknown or unnamed source. They came like angels out the unknown .
<u>unnamed</u>	Being or having an unknown or unnamed source. An unnamed donor.
<u>unnoticed</u>	Not noticed. A deliberate kick that went unnoticed by the referee.
unobserved	Not observed. Their courtship has not gone unobserved by Giles.
<u>unseen</u>	An unseen passage for translation. Unseen forces at work.
unsung	Not celebrated or praised. Harvey is one of the unsung heroes of the industrial revolution.
