Definitions of "Undisclosed" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “undisclosed” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not made known.*
- *Not revealed or made known publicly.*

Synonyms of "Undisclosed" as an adjective (8 Words)

concealed	Kept secret; hidden. <i>A concealed weapon.</i>
dark	Of a person having dark skin hair or eyes. <i>The dark ages.</i>
<u>hidden</u>	Not accessible to view. <i>Concealed or hidden damage.</i>
mysterious	Of an obscure nature- Rachel. <i>A mysterious benefactor provided the money.</i>
secret	Of information given in confidence or in secret. <i>Secret or private thoughts.</i>
unrevealed	Not made known. <i>Some feelings can run so deep that they are better left unrevealed.</i>

unspecified Not stated explicitly or in detail.
An **unspecified** number of people.

untold (of a story or event) not narrated or recounted.
No event however boring is left **untold**.

Usage Examples of "Undisclosed" as an adjective
