### Definitions of "Undisclosed" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “undisclosed” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not made known.*
- *Not revealed or made known publicly.*

### Synonyms of "Undisclosed" as an adjective (8 Words)

<b>concealed</b>	Kept secret; hidden. <i>A <b>concealed</b> weapon.</i>
<b>dark</b>	Of a person having dark skin hair or eyes. <i>The <b>dark</b> ages.</i>
<a href="#"><b>hidden</b></a>	Not accessible to view. <i>Concealed or <b>hidden</b> damage.</i>
<b>mysterious</b>	Of an obscure nature- Rachel. <i>A <b>mysterious</b> benefactor provided the money.</i>
<b>secret</b>	Of information given in confidence or in secret. <i><b>Secret</b> or private thoughts.</i>
<b>unrevealed</b>	Not made known. <i>Some feelings can run so deep that they are better left <b>unrevealed</b>.</i>

**unspecified** Not stated explicitly or in detail.  
An **unspecified** number of people.

**untold** (of a story or event) not narrated or recounted.  
No event however boring is left **untold**.

### Usage Examples of "Undisclosed" as an adjective

- *The precise terms of the agreement remained undisclosed.*
