Synonyms of "Undisclosed" as an adjective (8 Words)

concealed	Kept secret; hidden. A concealed weapon.
dark	Of a person having dark skin hair or eyes. <i>The dark ages.</i>
<u>hidden</u>	Not accessible to view. Concealed or hidden damage.
mysterious	Of an obscure nature- Rachel. A mysterious benefactor provided the money.
secret	Of information given in confidence or in secret. Secret or private thoughts.
unrevealed	Not made known. Some feelings can run so deep that they are better left unrevealed .



unspecifiedNot stated explicitly or in detail.
An unspecified number of people.untold(of a story or event) not narrated or recounted.
No event however boring is left untold.
