According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "undisputed" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Not disputed or called in question; accepted.
- Generally agreed upon; not subject to dispute.

Synonyms of "Undisputed" as an adjective (27 Words)

accepted Generally approved or compelling recognition.

clear-cut Clearly or sharply defined to the mind.

(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life

confirmed and unlikely to change their ways.

Received **confirmed** reports of casualties.

decided (of a quality) definite; unquestionable.

At a distinct or **decided** disadvantage.

definite (of a person) certain or sure about something.

It is **definite** that they have won.

incontestable Not open to question; obviously true.

incontrovertible Impossible to deny or disprove.

Incontrovertible proof.

indubitable Too obvious to be doubted.

An **indubitable** truth.

irrefutable Impossible to deny or disprove.

An irrefutable argument.

manifest Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment.

Manifest disapproval.

not in doubt Holding office.

not in question Currently fashionable.

positive Having a positive charge.

He is HIV **positive**.

recognized Generally approved or compelling recognition.

His **recognized** superiority in this kind of work.

Having or feeling no doubt or uncertainty confident and assured.

What is **sure** is that learning is a complex business.

unchallenged Not disputed or questioned.

The report s findings did not go **unchallenged**.

uncontested Not contested.

These claims have not gone **uncontested**.

undeniable Not possible to deny.

It is an **undeniable** fact that some dogs are easier to train than others.

Not guestioned or doubted by anyone.

undoubted

Her undoubted ability.

unequivocal Clearly defined or formulated.

An **unequivocal** or univocal statement.



unmistakable Clearly evident to the mind.

His opposition to slavery was unmistakable.

unquestionable Not able to be disputed or doubted.

An **unquestionable** antique.

unquestioned Not subjected to questioning.

His loyalty to John is **unquestioned**.
