<b>balmy</b>	Informal or slang terms for mentally irregular. <i>It used to drive my husband <b>balmy</b>.</i>
<b>halcyon</b>	Marked by peace and prosperity. <i>The <b>halcyon</b> days of the clipper trade.</i>
<b>pacific</b>	Relating to or bordering the Pacific Ocean. <i>A <b>pacific</b> gesture.</i>
<b>peaceful</b>	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>His <b>peaceful</b> mood vanished.</i>
<b>quiet</b>	Of the sun characterized by a low level of surface phenomena like sunspots e.g. <i>I ll have a <b>quiet</b> word with him.</i>
<b>relaxed</b>	(of a muscle or other body part) not tense. <i>We were having a great time and feeling very <b>relaxed</b>.</i>

<b><u>restful</u></b>	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>The rooms were cool and <b>restful</b>.</i>
<b><u>serene</u></b>	Completely clear and fine. <i>Her eyes were closed and she looked very <b>serene</b>.</i>
<b>still</b>	(of a drink) not effervescent. <i>The sheriff commanded him to stand <b>still</b> and drop the gun.</i>
<b><u>tranquil</u></b>	Not agitated; without losing self-possession. <i>A lake of <b>tranquil</b> blue water reflecting a <b>tranquil</b> blue sky.</i>
<b>unagitated</b>	Not agitated; without losing self-possession.
<b><u>unbothered</u></b>	Not worried or concerned. <i>She was <b>unbothered</b> by the mess in the sink.</i>
<b>unflustered</b>	Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension. <i>She seemed surprisingly <b>unflustered</b> by the delay.</i>
<b>unmoved</b>	Emotionally unmoved. <i>Her opponents were <b>unmoved</b> and plan to return to court.</i>
<b>unperturbed</b>	Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension- Anthony Trollope. <i>Kenneth seems <b>unperturbed</b> by the news.</i>
<b>unruffled</b>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>The <b>unruffled</b> waters of the lake.</i>
<b>untroubled</b>	Free from fear or doubt; easy in mind. <i><b>Untroubled</b> sleep.</i>
<b>windless</b>	Without or almost without wind. <i>He prefers <b>windless</b> days for playing golf.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Undisturbed" as an adjective

- *He could pursue his studies undisturbed.*
- *The tombs had lain undisturbed for 2,500 years.*
- *A quiet weekend of undisturbed tranquillity.*

<b>angelic</b>	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>Angelic</i> beneficence.
<b>beatific</b>	Imparting holy bliss. A <i>beatific</i> smile.
<b>blessed</b>	Roman Catholic proclaimed one of the blessed and thus worthy of veneration. Our <i>blessed</i> land.
<b>calm</b>	Become quiet or calm especially after a state of agitation. His usual <i>calm</i> deserted him.
<b>carefree</b>	Free of trouble and worry and care. We were young and <i>carefree</i> .

<u>casual</u>	A youth belonging to a subculture characterized by the wearing of expensive casual clothing and frequently associated with football hooliganism. <i>Casual</i> employment.
cool	Great coolness and composure under strain. A <i>cool</i> autumn day.
<u>creator</u>	Used as a name for God. Water the <i>creator</i> of climate and weather.
<u>devout</u>	Totally committed to a cause or belief. The most <i>devout</i> environmentalist.
<u>divine</u>	Resulting from divine providence. Paintings of shipwrecks being prevented by <i>divine</i> intervention.
easy	With ease easy is sometimes used informally for easily. An <i>easy</i> good natured manner.
godly	Emanating from God-Saturday Review. How to live the <i>godly</i> life.
halcyon	(Greek mythology) a woman who was turned into a kingfisher. A <i>halcyon</i> atmosphere.
hallowed	Worthy of religious veneration. Jerusalem s <i>hallowed</i> soil.
happy-go-lucky	Presaging or likely to bring good luck.
<u>heavenly</u>	Of or belonging to heaven or god. <i>Heavenly</i> Father.
insouciant	Showing a casual lack of concern. An elegantly <i>insouciant</i> manner.
inviolable	Must be kept sacred. An <i>inviolable</i> rule of chastity.
<u>leisurely</u>	In an unhurried way or at one's convenience. At a <i>leisurely</i> or easygoing pace.
<u>nonchalant</u>	Marked by blithe unconcern. Drove his car with <i>nonchalant</i> abandon.
<u>pilgrimage</u>	Go on a pilgrimage. Now is the thirty first year of my dark <i>pilgrimage</i> on this earth.
possession	The act of having and controlling property. He remains in full <i>possession</i> of his sanity.
relaxed	Free from tension and anxiety. Gave the impression of being quite <i>relaxed</i> .



<b>sacred</b>	Regarded as too valuable to be interfered with; sacrosanct. <i>The <b>sacred</b> mosque.</i>
<b>saintly</b>	Very holy or virtuous. <i>A truly <b>saintly</b> woman.</i>
<b>shrine</b>	Enshrine. <i>Her grave has become a <b>shrine</b> for fans from all over the world.</i>
<b>supernal</b>	Of exceptional quality or extent. <i><b>Supernal</b> erudition.</i>
<b>unconcerned</b>	Lacking in interest or care or feeling. <i>The average American is <b>unconcerned</b> that his or her plight is the result of a complex of personal and economic and governmental actions beyond the normal citizen's comprehension and control.</i>
<b>unmolested</b>	Not pestered or molested; left in peace. <i>They allowed him to pass <b>unmolested</b>.</i>
<b>untroubled</b>	Free from turmoil or worries. <i>Seemed <b>untroubled</b> by doubts of any kind.</i>
