- *To an unwarranted degree; inordinately.*

### Synonyms of "Unduly" as an adverb (6 Words)

| <b>disproportionately</b>    | To an extent that is too large or too small in comparison with something else.<br><i>A tax cut would <b>disproportionately</b> benefit the rich.</i> |
| <b>excessively</b>           | To a degree exceeding normal or proper limits.<br><i>They don't drink <b>excessively</b>.</i>  |
| <b>immoderately</b>          | To a degree that exceeds the bounds or reason or moderation.   |
| <b>inordinately</b>          | Extremely.<br><i>Negotiations took an <b>inordinately</b> long time.</i>   |
| <b>intemperately</b>         | Indulging excessively.   |
| <b>out of all proportion</b> | Away from home.  |
