Definitions of "Unduly" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unduly” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *To an undue degree.*
- *To an unwarranted degree; inordinately.*

Synonyms of "Unduly" as an adverb (6 Words)

disproportionately	To an extent that is too large or too small in comparison with something else. <i>A tax cut would disproportionately benefit the rich.</i>
excessively	To a degree exceeding normal or proper limits. <i>They don't drink excessively.</i>
immoderately	To a degree that exceeds the bounds or reason or moderation.
inordinately	Extremely. <i>Negotiations took an inordinately long time.</i>
intemperately	Indulging excessively.
out of all proportion	Away from home.
