- *Continuing forever or indefinitely.*

Synonyms of "Unending" as an adjective (9 Words)

aeonian	Continuing forever or indefinitely.
ageless	Never looking old or appearing to grow old. <i>We often praise celebrities for their ageless appearance.</i>
endless	Infinitely great in number. <i>Endless</i> loop cassette tapes.
eonian	Of or relating to a geological eon (longer than an era).
eternal	Seeming to last or persist forever, especially on account of being tedious or annoying. <i>Eternal</i> nagging demands.
everlasting	Continuing forever or indefinitely. <i>An everlasting reminder of this evening.</i>

never-ending Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing.

perpetual Continuing forever or indefinitely.
*Deep caves in **perpetual** darkness.*

unceasing Not coming to an end; continuous.
*The **unceasing** efforts of the staff.*

Usage Examples of "Unending" as an adjective

- *Unending demands.*
- *The unending bliss of heaven.*
- *The charity rescues children from unending poverty.*
