### Synonyms of "Unenthusiastic" as an adjective (19 Words)

<b><u>apathetic</u></b>	Marked by a lack of interest. <i>A woman who became active rather than <b>apathetic</b> as she grew older.</i>
<b><u>casual</u></b>	(of a sexual relationship or encounter) occurring between people who are not regular or established sexual partners. <i>An ability to interest <b>casual</b> students.</i>
<b><u>cool</u></b>	Inducing the impression of coolness used especially of greens and blues and violets when referring to color. <i>The wind kept them <b>cool</b>.</i>
<b><u>cursory</u></b>	Hasty and without attention to detail; not thorough. <i>A <b>cursory</b> glance at the figures.</i>

<b>emotionless</b>	Unmoved by feeling. <i>Her voice was flat and <b>emotionless</b>.</i>
<b>half-hearted</b>	Feeling or showing little interest or enthusiasm.
<b>indifferent</b>	Marked by a lack of interest. <i>An <b>indifferent</b> performance.</i>
<b>lacklustre</b>	Lacking in vitality, force, or conviction; uninspired or uninspiring. <i>The conditioner will revitalize <b>lacklustre</b> hair.</i>
<b><u>languid</u></b>	Weak or faint from illness or fatigue. <i>His <b>languid</b> demeanour irritated her.</i>
<b><u>lethargic</u></b>	Deficient in alertness or activity. <i>Bullfrogs became <b>lethargic</b> with the first cold nights.</i>
<b><u>listless</u></b>	Lacking zest or vivacity. <i>Bouts of <b>listless</b> depression.</i>
<b>lukewarm</b>	Showing little enthusiasm. <i>They drank bitter <b>lukewarm</b> coffee.</i>
<b>offhand</b>	Ungraciously or offensively nonchalant or cool in manner. <i><b>Offhand</b> excuses.</i>
<b><u>passive</u></b>	(of a heating system) making use of incident sunlight as an energy source. <i>Academics seem to favor <b>passive</b> sentences.</i>
<b><u>perfunctory</u></b>	As a formality only. <i>He gave a <b>perfunctory</b> nod.</i>
<b>phlegmatic</b>	(of a person) having an unemotional and stolidly calm disposition. <i>A <b>phlegmatic</b> and certainly undemonstrative man.</i>
<b>tepid</b>	Moderately warm. <i>The applause was <b>tepid</b>.</i>
<b><u>uninvolved</u></b>	Not involved. <i>An <b>uninvolved</b> bystander.</i>
<b>unmoved</b>	Emotionally unmoved. <i>He was clearly <b>unmoved</b> by her outburst.</i>
