half-hearted Feeling or showing little interest or enthusiasm.

indifferent Marked by a lack of interest.

An **indifferent** performance.

lacklustre Lacking in vitality, force, or conviction; uninspiring.

The conditioner will revitalize **lacklustre** hair.

languid Weak or faint from illness or fatigue.

His languid demeanour irritated her.

Deficient in alertness or activity.

Bullfrogs became **lethargic** with the first cold nights.

Lacking zest or vivacity.

Bouts of **listless** depression.

lukewarm Showing little enthusiasm.
They drank bitter lukewarm coffee.

They drank bitter **tukewarm** cojjee.

offhand Ungraciously or offensively nonchalant or cool in manner.

Offhand excuses.

(of a heating system) making use of incident sunlight as an energy source.

Academics seem to favor **passive** sentences.

perfunctory As a formality only.

He gave a **perfunctory** nod.

phlegmatic (of a person) having an unemotional and stolidly calm disposition.

A **phlegmatic** and certainly undemonstrative man.

tepid Moderately warm.

The applause was **tepid**.

uninvolved Not involved.

An **uninvolved** bystander.

unmoved Emotionally unmoved.

He was clearly **unmoved** by her outburst.
