Synonyms of "Unenthusiastic" as an adjective (19 Words)

apathetic	Marked by a lack of interest. <i>A woman who became active rather than apathetic as she grew older.</i>
casual	(of a sexual relationship or encounter) occurring between people who are not regular or established sexual partners. <i>An ability to interest casual students.</i>
cool	Inducing the impression of coolness used especially of greens and blues and violets when referring to color. <i>The wind kept them cool.</i>
cursory	Hasty and without attention to detail; not thorough. <i>A cursory glance at the figures.</i>

emotionless	Unmoved by feeling. <i>Her voice was flat and emotionless.</i>
half-hearted	Feeling or showing little interest or enthusiasm.
indifferent	Marked by a lack of interest. <i>An indifferent performance.</i>
lacklustre	Lacking in vitality, force, or conviction; uninspired or uninspiring. <i>The conditioner will revitalize lacklustre hair.</i>
<u>languid</u>	Weak or faint from illness or fatigue. <i>His languid demeanour irritated her.</i>
<u>lethargic</u>	Deficient in alertness or activity. <i>Bullfrogs became lethargic with the first cold nights.</i>
<u>listless</u>	Lacking zest or vivacity. <i>Bouts of listless depression.</i>
lukewarm	Showing little enthusiasm. <i>They drank bitter lukewarm coffee.</i>
offhand	Ungraciously or offensively nonchalant or cool in manner. <i>Offhand excuses.</i>
<u>passive</u>	(of a heating system) making use of incident sunlight as an energy source. <i>Academics seem to favor passive sentences.</i>
<u>perfunctory</u>	As a formality only. <i>He gave a perfunctory nod.</i>
phlegmatic	(of a person) having an unemotional and stolidly calm disposition. <i>A phlegmatic and certainly undemonstrative man.</i>
tepid	Moderately warm. <i>The applause was tepid.</i>
<u>uninvolved</u>	Not involved. <i>An uninvolved bystander.</i>
unmoved	Emotionally unmoved. <i>He was clearly unmoved by her outburst.</i>
