<a href="#">bland</a>	Lacking taste or flavor or tang. <b>Bland</b> mass produced pop music.
<b>boring</b>	So lacking in interest as to cause mental weariness. <i>I ve got a <b>boring</b> job in an office.</i>
<b>commonplace</b>	Repeated too often; overfamiliar through overuse. <i>Unemployment was <b>commonplace</b> in his trade.</i>
<b>dull</b>	(of activity) sluggish or slow-moving. <b>Dull</b> greens and blues.
<a href="#">everyday</a>	Found in the ordinary course of events- Anita Diamant. <b>Everyday</b> clothes.

<b><u>flat</u></b>	Of a key having a flat or flats in the signature. <i>The <b>flat</b> roof of a garage.</i>
<b>humdrum</b>	Tediously repetitious or lacking in variety. <i><b>Humdrum</b> routine work.</i>
<b>insipid</b>	Lacking flavour; weak or tasteless. <i><b>Insipid</b> hospital food.</i>
<b><u>monotonous</u></b>	Tediously repetitious or lacking in variety. <i>Nothing is so <b>monotonous</b> as the sea.</i>
<b><u>mundane</u></b>	Concerned with the world or worldly matters. <i>His <b>mundane</b> humdrum existence.</i>
<b>ordinary</b>	Not exceptional in any way especially in quality or ability or size or degree. <i><b>Ordinary</b> decency.</i>
<b><u>pedestrian</u></b>	Lacking inspiration or excitement; dull. <i>Disenchantment with their <b>pedestrian</b> lives.</i>
<b><u>predictable</u></b>	Capable of being foretold. <i>The characters are stereotyped and extremely <b>predictable</b>.</i>
<b>routine</b>	Performed as part of a regular procedure rather than for a special reason. <i>The Ministry insisted that this was just a <b>routine</b> annual drill.</i>
<b>run-of-the-mill</b>	Not special in any way.
<b>slow</b>	Slow to learn or understand lacking intellectual acuity Thackeray. <i>The <b>slow</b> lane.</i>
<b><u>tedious</u></b>	Using or containing too many words. <i>A <b>tedious</b> journey.</i>
<b><u>unchanging</u></b>	Not changing; remaining the same. <i>The party stood for <b>unchanging</b> principles.</i>
<b>unexceptional</b>	Not special in any way; lacking distinction. <i>An <b>unexceptional</b> movie.</i>
<b>unexciting</b>	Not stimulating. <i>Many school prospectuses are dull and <b>unexciting</b>.</i>
<b>uninspiring</b>	Not producing excitement or interest. <i>An <b>uninspiring</b> game that United scarcely deserved to win.</i>
<b>uninteresting</b>	Not arousing curiosity or interest. <i>A very <b>uninteresting</b> account of her trip.</i>
<b>unmemorable</b>	Not memorable. <i>Characterless boring <b>unmemorable</b> buildings.</i>

**unremarkable** Found in the ordinary course of events.  
An ***unremarkable*** house.

**unvaried** Lacking variety.  
A plain ***unvaried*** diet.
