<b>abstruse</b>	Difficult to penetrate; incomprehensible to one of ordinary understanding or knowledge. <i>An <b>abstruse</b> philosophical inquiry.</i>
<a href="#">arcane</a>	Requiring secret or mysterious knowledge. <i>The <b>arcane</b> science of dowsing.</i>
<a href="#">astonishing</a>	Surprising greatly. <i>An <b>astonishing</b> achievement.</i>

<b>baffling</b>	Making great mental demands; hard to comprehend or solve or believe. <i>The crime is a <b>baffling</b> mystery for the police.</i>
<b><u>bewildering</u></b>	Confusing or perplexing. <i>There is a <b>bewildering</b> array of holidays to choose from.</i>
<b>bizarre</b>	Very strange or unusual. <i>His behaviour became more and more <b>bizarre</b>.</i>
<b>curious</b>	Beyond or deviating from the usual or expected. <i><b>Curious</b> about the neighbor s doings.</i>
<b>enigmatic</b>	Not clear to the understanding. <i>Prophetic texts so <b>enigmatic</b> that their meaning has been disputed for centuries.</i>
<b>extraordinary</b>	(of an official) specially employed in addition to the usual staff. <i>An <b>extraordinary</b> achievement.</i>
<b>freakish</b>	Characteristic of a freak. <i><b>Freakish</b> weather.</i>
<b>impenetrable</b>	(of matter) incapable of occupying the same space as other matter at the same time. <i><b>Impenetrable</b> jargon.</i>
<b>incomprehensible</b>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i>The most <b>incomprehensible</b> thing about the universe is that it is comprehensible.</i>
<b><u>inexplicable</u></b>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i><b>Inexplicable</b> errors.</i>
<b>inscrutable</b>	Of an obscure nature- Rachel. <i>Guy looked blankly <b>inscrutable</b>.</i>
<b>insoluble</b>	Incapable of being dissolved. <i>An <b>insoluble</b> problem.</i>
<b>mysterious</b>	Of an obscure nature. <i>His colleague had vanished in <b>mysterious</b> circumstances.</i>
<b>mystifying</b>	Of an obscure nature. <i>Rituals totally <b>mystifying</b> to visitors from other lands.</i>
<b><u>obscure</u></b>	Remote and separate physically or socially. <i>An impulse to go off and fight certain <b>obscure</b> battles of his own spirit.</i>
<b><u>odd</u></b>	Not easily explained. <i>It s <b>odd</b> that she didn t recognize me.</i>

<b>peculiar</b>	Markedly different from the usual. <i>The <b>peculiar</b> character of the Government of the U S.</i>
<b>perplexing</b>	Lacking clarity of meaning; causing confusion or perplexity. <i>A <b>perplexing</b> problem.</i>
<u><b>puzzling</b></u>	Lacking clarity of meaning; causing confusion or perplexity. <i>A <b>puzzling</b> statement.</i>
<b>strange</b>	Relating to or originating in or characteristic of another place or part of the world. <i>She was lost in a <b>strange</b> country.</i>
<b>unaccountable</b>	(of a person, organization, or institution) not required or expected to justify actions or decisions; not responsible for results or consequences. <i>A strange and <b>unaccountable</b> fact.</i>
<u><b>unfathomable</b></u>	Impossible to come to understand. <i>Mountains of <b>unfathomable</b> scale.</i>
<u><b>unparalleled</b></u>	Radically distinctive and without equal. <i><b>Unparalleled</b> athletic ability.</i>
<b>unsolvable</b>	Not solved. <i>Public finance had long presented problems <b>unsolvable</b> or at least unsolved.</i>
<b>unusual</b>	Not usual or common or ordinary. <i>A man of <b>unusual</b> ability.</i>
