<b>inestimable</b>	Beyond calculation or measure. A treasure of <b>inestimable</b> value.
<b><u>infinite</u></b>	Total and all-embracing. The <b>infinite</b> number of stars in the universe.
<b><u>limitless</u></b>	Without end, limit, or boundary. <b>Limitless</b> vastness of our solar system.
<b>measureless</b>	Having no bounds or limits; unlimited. Otto had <b>measureless</b> charm.
<b>never-ending</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing.
<b>reliable</b>	Worthy of being depended on. A <b>reliable</b> source of information.
<b>steadfast</b>	Firm and dependable especially in loyalty. <b>Steadfast</b> resolve.
<b><u>steady</u></b>	Not subject to change or variation especially in behavior. A good <b>steady</b> ballplayer.
<b><u>sure</u></b>	Having or feeling no doubt or uncertainty confident and assured. Was very <b>sure</b> in his beliefs.
<b><u>unbounded</u></b>	Having or appearing to have no limits. <b>Unbounded</b> enthusiasm.
<b><u>unending</u></b>	Countless or continual. <b>Unending</b> demands.
<b>unflagging</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <b>Unflagging</b> courtesy.

<b>unlimited</b>	That cannot be entirely consumed or used up. <i>To start with a theory of <b>unlimited</b> freedom is to end up with <b>unlimited</b> despotism.</i>
<b>untold</b>	Too much to be measured. <i>No event however boring is left <b>untold</b>.</i>
