Synonyms of "Unfaltering" as an adjective (26 Words)

decided	(of a person) having clear opinions; resolute. <i>He quotes from decided cases.</i>
firm	Marked by firm determination or resolution not shakable. <i>The post was still firm after being hit by the car.</i>
fixed	Having a fixed and unchanging value. <i>A fixed iron ladder down the port side.</i>
indefatigable	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>An indefatigable defender of human rights.</i>

inexorable	(of a person) impossible to persuade; unrelenting. <i>Cynthia was inexorable she would have none of him.</i>
persistent	(of chemicals or radioactivity) remaining within the environment for a long time after introduction. <i>PCBs are persistent environmental contaminants.</i>
relentless	Harsh or inflexible. <i>A patient but relentless taskmaster.</i>
resolute	Firm in purpose or belief; characterized by firmness and determination. <i>A resolute and unshakeable faith.</i>
resolved	Firmly determined to do something. <i>Mysteries solved and unsolved problems resolved and unresolved.</i>
steadfast	Firm and dependable especially in loyalty. <i>Steadfast resolve.</i>
steady	(of a ship) moving without deviation from its course. <i>A steady gaze.</i>
stiff	Incapable of or resistant to bending. <i>A stiff breeze.</i>
sustained	(of an electric arc) continuous. <i>Sustained flight.</i>
tireless	Having or showing great effort or energy. <i>A tireless worker.</i>
unbendable	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable. <i>Rigid unbendable rules.</i>
unflagging	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>Unflagging pursuit of excellence.</i>
unfluctuating	Not liable to fluctuate or especially to fall.
unhesitating	Characterized by quickness and firmness. <i>His reply was unhesitating.</i>
unrelenting	Punishingly harsh. <i>The heat was unrelenting.</i>
unremitting	Never relaxing or slackening; incessant. <i>Unremitting drizzle.</i>
unshakable	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable.
unshakeable	Unable to be disputed or questioned. <i>An unshakeable alibi.</i>
unswerving	Not changing or becoming weaker; steady or constant. <i>A straight and narrow tree lined road unswerving across the lowlands.</i>

untiring (of a person or their actions) continuing at the same rate without loss of vigour.

*His **untiring** efforts in commissioning ecological reports.*

unwavering

Not showing abrupt variations.

*She fixed him with an **unwavering** stare.*

unyielding

Stubbornly unyielding.

*The Atlantic hurled its waves at the **unyielding** rocks.*
