### Synonyms of "Unfaltering" as an adjective (26 Words)

<b>decided</b>	(of a person) having clear opinions; resolute. <i>He quotes from <b>decided</b> cases.</i>
<b>firm</b>	Marked by firm determination or resolution not shakable. <i>The post was still <b>firm</b> after being hit by the car.</i>
<b>fixed</b>	Having a fixed and unchanging value. <i>A <b>fixed</b> iron ladder down the port side.</i>
<b>indefatigable</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>An <b>indefatigable</b> defender of human rights.</i>

<b>inexorable</b>	(of a person) impossible to persuade; unrelenting. <i>Cynthia was <b>inexorable</b> she would have none of him.</i>
<b>persistent</b>	(of chemicals or radioactivity) remaining within the environment for a long time after introduction. <i>PCBs are <b>persistent</b> environmental contaminants.</i>
<b>relentless</b>	Harsh or inflexible. <i>A patient but <b>relentless</b> taskmaster.</i>
<b>resolute</b>	Firm in purpose or belief; characterized by firmness and determination. <i>A <b>resolute</b> and unshakeable faith.</i>
<b>resolved</b>	Firmly determined to do something. <i>Mysteries solved and unsolved problems <b>resolved</b> and <b>unresolved</b>.</i>
<b>steadfast</b>	Firm and dependable especially in loyalty. <i><b>Steadfast</b> resolve.</i>
<b>steady</b>	(of a ship) moving without deviation from its course. <i>A <b>steady</b> gaze.</i>
<b>stiff</b>	Incapable of or resistant to bending. <i>A <b>stiff</b> breeze.</i>
<b>sustained</b>	(of an electric arc) continuous. <i><b>Sustained</b> flight.</i>
<b>tireless</b>	Having or showing great effort or energy. <i>A <b>tireless</b> worker.</i>
<b>unbendable</b>	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable. <i>Rigid <b>unbendable</b> rules.</i>
<b>unflagging</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i><b>Unflagging</b> pursuit of excellence.</i>
<b>unfluctuating</b>	Not liable to fluctuate or especially to fall.
<b>unhesitating</b>	Characterized by quickness and firmness. <i>His reply was <b>unhesitating</b>.</i>
<b>unrelenting</b>	Punishingly harsh. <i>The heat was <b>unrelenting</b>.</i>
<b>unremitting</b>	Never relaxing or slackening; incessant. <i><b>Unremitting</b> drizzle.</i>
<b>unshakable</b>	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable.
<b>unshakeable</b>	Unable to be disputed or questioned. <i>An <b>unshakeable</b> alibi.</i>
<b>unswerving</b>	Not changing or becoming weaker; steady or constant. <i>A straight and narrow tree lined road <b>unswerving</b> across the lowlands.</i>

**untiring** (of a person or their actions) continuing at the same rate without loss of vigour.

*His **untiring** efforts in commissioning ecological reports.*

**unwavering** Not showing abrupt variations.

*She fixed him with an **unwavering** stare.*

**unyielding** Stubbornly unyielding.

*The Atlantic hurled its waves at the **unyielding** rocks.*
