(of chemicals or radioactivity) remaining within the environment for a long

persistent time after introduction.

PCBs are **persistent** environmental contaminants.

Harsh or inflexible.

relentless
A patient but relentless taskmaster.

resolute Firm in purpose or belief; characterized by firmness and determination.

A **resolute** and unshakeable faith.

resolved Firmly determined to do something.

Mysteries solved and unsolved problems **resolved** and un**resolved**.

steadfast. Firm and dependable especially in loyalty.

Steadfast resolve.

steady (of a ship) moving without deviation from its course.

A **steady** gaze.

stiff Incapable of or resistant to bending.

A **stiff** breeze.

sustained (of an electric arc) continuous.

Sustained flight.

tireless Having or showing great effort or energy.

A **tireless** worker.

unbendable Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable.

Rigid **unbendable** rules.

unflagging

Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality.

Unflagging pursuit of excellence.

unfluctuating Not liable to fluctuate or especially to fall.

unhesitating Characterized by quickness and firmness.

His reply was **unhesitating**.

Punishingly harsh.

unrelenting
The heat was unrelenting.

Never relaxing or slackening; incessant.

unremitting Unremitting drizzle.

unshakable Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable.

Unable to be disputed or questioned.

unshakeable An unshakeable alibi.

. Not changing or becoming weaker; steady or constant.

unswervingA straight and narrow tree lined road **unswerving** across the lowlands.
