## Synonyms of "Unfaltering" as an adjective (26 Words)

decided	(of a person) having clear opinions; resolute. <i>He quotes from <b>decided</b> cases.</i>
firm	Marked by firm determination or resolution not shakable. The post was still <b>firm</b> after being hit by the car.
fixed	Having a fixed and unchanging value. A <b>fixed</b> iron ladder down the port side.
indefatigable	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. An <b>indefatigable</b> defender of human rights.



inexorable	(of a person) impossible to persuade; unrelenting. Cynthia was <b>inexorable</b> she would have none of him.
persistent	(of chemicals or radioactivity) remaining within the environment for a long time after introduction. <i>PCBs are <b>persistent</b> environmental contaminants.</i>
<u>relentless</u>	Harsh or inflexible. A patient but <b>relentless</b> taskmaster.
<u>resolute</u>	Firm in purpose or belief; characterized by firmness and determination. <i>A</i> <b>resolute</b> and unshakeable faith.
resolved	Firmly determined to do something. Mysteries solved and unsolved problems <b>resolved</b> and un <b>resolved</b> .
steadfast	Firm and dependable especially in loyalty. <i>Steadfast</i> resolve.
<u>steady</u>	(of a ship) moving without deviation from its course. A <b>steady</b> gaze.
<u>stiff</u>	Incapable of or resistant to bending. A <b>stiff</b> breeze.
sustained	(of an electric arc) continuous. <i>Sustained flight.</i>
<u>tireless</u>	Having or showing great effort or energy. A <b>tireless</b> worker.
unbendable	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable. <i>Rigid</i> <b>unbendable</b> rules.
unflagging	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>Unflagging</i> pursuit of excellence.
unfluctuating	Not liable to fluctuate or especially to fall.
unhesitating	Characterized by quickness and firmness. <i>His reply was <b>unhesitating</b></i> .
<u>unrelenting</u>	Punishingly harsh. The heat was <b>unrelenting</b> .
<u>unremitting</u>	Never relaxing or slackening; incessant. <b>Unremitting</b> drizzle.
unshakable	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable.
<u>unshakeable</u>	Unable to be disputed or questioned. An <b>unshakeable</b> alibi.
unswerving	Not changing or becoming weaker; steady or constant. A straight and narrow tree lined road <b>unswerving</b> across the lowlands.



untiring	(of a person or their actions) continuing at the same rate without loss of vigour. His <b>untiring</b> efforts in commissioning ecological reports.
<u>unwavering</u>	Not showing abrupt variations. She fixed him with an <b>unwavering</b> stare.
unyielding	Stubbornly unyielding. The Atlantic hurled its waves at the <b>unyielding</b> rocks.
