nonchalant Marked by blithe unconcern.

relaxed (of a muscle or other body part) not tense.

The **relaxed** atmosphere of the hotel.

Serene Calm, peaceful, and untroubled; tranquil.

Her eyes were closed and she looked very **serene**.

unexcitable Not easily excited.

An **unexcitable** temperament.

**unruffled** Free from disturbance by heavy waves.

With contented mind and **unruffled** spirit.

Not beset by troubles or disturbance or distress.

untroubled Untroubled sleep.

Not anxious or uneasy.

**unworried**Foreign investors are largely **unworried** by the government s fall.
