Synonyms of "Unfazed" as an adjective (18 Words)

blithe	Showing a casual and cheerful indifference considered to be callous or improper. <i>A merry blithesome nature.</i>
carefree	Cheerfully irresponsible. <i>We were young and carefree.</i>
equable	Not easily disturbed or angered; calm and even-tempered. <i>He could look sterner than his equable temperament would suggest.</i>
even-tempered	Not easily irritated.
free and easy	Costing nothing.
happy-go-lucky	Presaging or likely to bring good luck.

<u>imperturbable</u>	Not easily perturbed or excited or upset; marked by extreme calm and composure. <i>An imperturbable tranquillity.</i>
insouciant	Marked by blithe unconcern. <i>An insouciant shrug.</i>
mellow	(of earth) rich and loamy. <i>Everybody got very mellow and slept well.</i>
<u>mild</u>	Humble in spirit or manner suggesting retiring mildness or even cowed submissiveness. <i>Mild winters.</i>
<u>nonchalant</u>	Marked by blithe unconcern. <i>Was polite in a teasing nonchalant manner.</i>
<u>placid</u>	Not easily irritated. <i>Not everyone shared his placid temperament.</i>
relaxed	(of a muscle or other body part) not tense. <i>The relaxed atmosphere of the hotel.</i>
<u>serene</u>	Calm, peaceful, and untroubled; tranquil. <i>Her eyes were closed and she looked very serene.</i>
unexcitable	Not easily excited. <i>An unexcitable temperament.</i>
unruffled	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>With contented mind and unruffled spirit.</i>
untroubled	Not beset by troubles or disturbance or distress. <i>Untroubled sleep.</i>
<u>unworried</u>	Not anxious or uneasy. <i>Foreign investors are largely unworried by the government's fall.</i>

Usage Examples of "Unfazed" as an adjective

- *The protestors were unfazed by the prospect of arrest.*
