### Synonyms of "Unfazed" as an adjective (18 Words)

<b>blithe</b>	Showing a casual and cheerful indifference considered to be callous or improper. <i>A merry <b>blithesome</b> nature.</i>
<b>carefree</b>	Cheerfully irresponsible. <i>We were young and <b>carefree</b>.</i>
<b>equable</b>	Not easily disturbed or angered; calm and even-tempered. <i>He could look sterner than his <b>equable</b> temperament would suggest.</i>
<b>even-tempered</b>	Not easily irritated.
<b>free and easy</b>	Costing nothing.
<b>happy-go-lucky</b>	Presaging or likely to bring good luck.

<b><u>imperturbable</u></b>	Not easily perturbed or excited or upset; marked by extreme calm and composure. <i>An <b>imperturbable</b> tranquillity.</i>
<b>insouciant</b>	Marked by blithe unconcern. <i>An <b>insouciant</b> shrug.</i>
<b>mellow</b>	(of earth) rich and loamy. <i>Everybody got very <b>mellow</b> and slept well.</i>
<b><u>mild</u></b>	Humble in spirit or manner suggesting retiring mildness or even cowed submissiveness. <i><b>Mild</b> winters.</i>
<b><u>nonchalant</u></b>	Marked by blithe unconcern. <i>Was polite in a teasing <b>nonchalant</b> manner.</i>
<b><u>placid</u></b>	Not easily irritated. <i>Not everyone shared his <b>placid</b> temperament.</i>
<b>relaxed</b>	(of a muscle or other body part) not tense. <i>The <b>relaxed</b> atmosphere of the hotel.</i>
<b><u>serene</u></b>	Calm, peaceful, and untroubled; tranquil. <i>Her eyes were closed and she looked very <b>serene</b>.</i>
<b>unexcitable</b>	Not easily excited. <i>An <b>unexcitable</b> temperament.</i>
<b>unruffled</b>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>With contented mind and <b>unruffled</b> spirit.</i>
<b>untroubled</b>	Not beset by troubles or disturbance or distress. <i><b>Untroubled</b> sleep.</i>
<b><u>unworried</u></b>	Not anxious or uneasy. <i>Foreign investors are largely <b>unworried</b> by the government's fall.</i>
