Definitions of "Unfurl" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unfurl” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make or become spread out from a rolled or folded state, especially in order to be open to the wind.*
- *Unroll, unfold, or spread out or be unrolled, unfolded, or spread out from a furled state.*



Synonyms of "Unfurl" as a verb (16 Words)

disentangle	Free from involvement or entanglement. <i>Can you disentangle the cord.</i>
lay out	Put into a certain place or abstract location.
open	Have an opening or passage or outlet. <i>Two new restaurants open this week.</i>
open out	Become available.
spread out	Spread out or open from a closed or folded state.
straighten	Straighten up or out make straight. <i>He slowly straightened up using the table for support.</i>
straighten out	Make straight.
uncoil	Straighten or cause to straighten from a coiled or curled position. <i>She uncoiled her feather boa.</i>

undo	Cancel, annul, or reverse an action or its effect. <i>The knot was difficult to undo.</i>
unkink	Straighten or become straight. <i>The next job was to unkink the twisted Christmas lights.</i>
unravel	Investigate and solve or explain (something complicated or puzzling). <i>Can you unravel the mystery.</i>
unreel	(of a film) wind from one reel to another during projection. <i>Unreel the tape.</i>
unroll	Unroll unfold or spread out or be unrolled unfolded or spread out from a furled state. <i>The blanket unrolled as he tugged it.</i>
unsnarl	Extricate from entanglement. <i>He helped her unsnarl her muddled views.</i>
untwine	Make or become unwound or untwisted. <i>Robyn untwined her fingers.</i>
unwind	Reverse the winding or twisting of. <i>The Grand Hotel is a superb place to unwind.</i>



Usage Examples of "Unfurl" as a verb

- *The flags unfurl.*
- *A man was unfurling a sail.*
- *Unfurl a banner.*
