## Unfurl as a Verb

### Definitions of "Unfurl" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unfurl” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make or become spread out from a rolled or folded state, especially in order to be open to the wind.*
- *Unroll, unfold, or spread out or be unrolled, unfolded, or spread out from a furled state.*



## Synonyms of "Unfurl" as a verb (16 Words)

<b>disentangle</b>	Free from involvement or entanglement. <i>Can you <b>disentangle</b> the cord.</i>
<b>lay out</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location.
<b>open</b>	Have an opening or passage or outlet. <i>Two new restaurants <b>open</b> this week.</i>
<b>open out</b>	Become available.
<b>spread out</b>	Spread out or open from a closed or folded state.
<b>straighten</b>	Straighten up or out make straight. <i>He slowly <b>straightened</b> up using the table for support.</i>
<b>straighten out</b>	Make straight.
<b>uncoil</b>	Straighten or cause to straighten from a coiled or curled position. <i>She <b>uncoiled</b> her feather boa.</i>

<b><u>undo</u></b>	Cancel, annul, or reverse an action or its effect. <i>The knot was difficult to <b>undo</b>.</i>
<b>unkink</b>	Straighten or become straight. <i>The next job was to <b>unkink</b> the twisted Christmas lights.</i>
<b>unravel</b>	Investigate and solve or explain (something complicated or puzzling). <i>Can you <b>unravel</b> the mystery.</i>
<b>unreel</b>	(of a film) wind from one reel to another during projection. <i><b>Unreel</b> the tape.</i>
<b>unroll</b>	Unroll unfold or spread out or be unrolled unfolded or spread out from a furled state. <i>The blanket <b>unrolled</b> as he tugged it.</i>
<b>unsnarl</b>	Extricate from entanglement. <i>He helped her <b>unsnarl</b> her muddled views.</i>
<b>untwine</b>	Make or become unwound or untwisted. <i>Robyn <b>untwined</b> her fingers.</i>
<b>unwind</b>	Reverse the winding or twisting of. <i>The Grand Hotel is a superb place to <b>unwind</b>.</i>

- *Unfurl a banner.*
