**disentangle** Free from involvement or entanglement.

Can you **disentangle** the cord.

lay out Put into a certain place or abstract location.

Have an opening or passage or outlet. Two new restaurants **open** this week.

**open out** Become available.

open

**spread out** Spread out or open from a closed or folded state.

Straighten up or out make straight.

straighten

He slowly straightened up using the table for support.

straighten out Make straight.

uncoil Straighten or cause to straighten from a coiled or curled position.

She **uncoil**ed her feather boa.



undo Cancel, annul, or reverse an action or its effect.

The knot was difficult to **undo**.

unkink Straighten or become straight.

The next job was to **unkink** the twisted Christmas lights.

**unravel** Investigate and solve or explain (something complicated or puzzling.

Can you **unravel** the mystery.

unreel (of a film) wind from one reel to another during projection.

**Unreel** the tape.

Unroll unfold or spread out or be unrolled unfolded or spread out from a

**unroll** furled state.

The blanket **unroll**ed as he tugged it.

**unsnarl** Extricate from entanglement.

He helped her **unsnarl** her muddled views.

untwine Make or become unwound or untwisted.

Robyn **untwine**d her fingers.

**unwind** Reverse the winding or twisting of.

The Grand Hotel is a superb place to **unwind**.
