Synonyms of "Ungrateful" as an adjective (4 Words)

thankless	(of a person) not expressing or feeling gratitude. <i>How sharper than a serpent s tooth it is To have a thankless child.</i>
<u>unappreciative</u>	Not fully understanding, recognizing, or valuing something. They were unappreciative of country problems.
ungracious	Lacking social graces. After Anna s kindness I wouldn t want to seem ungracious .
unthankful	Not feeling or showing gratitude- Shakespeare. No company ever went from them unthankful .



Usage Examples of "Ungrateful" as an adjective

- She's so ungrateful for everything we do.
- *I* will not perform the ungrateful task of comparing cases of failure.
- *He turned to the ungrateful task of forming a police cordon.*
- Ungrateful heirs.
