Synonyms of "Ungrateful" as an adjective (4 Words)

thankless	(of a person) not expressing or feeling gratitude. <i>How sharper than a serpent s tooth it is To have a thankless child.</i>
unappreciative	Not fully understanding, recognizing, or valuing something. <i>They were unappreciative of country problems.</i>
ungracious	Lacking social graces. <i>After Anna s kindness I wouldn t want to seem ungracious.</i>
unthankful	Not feeling or showing gratitude- Shakespeare. <i>No company ever went from them unthankful.</i>

Usage Examples of "Ungrateful" as an adjective

- *She's so ungrateful for everything we do.*
- *I will not perform the ungrateful task of comparing cases of failure.*
- *He turned to the ungrateful task of forming a police cordon.*
- *Ungrateful heirs.*
