unappreciative Not fully understanding, recognizing, or valuing something.

They were **unappreciative** of country problems.

ungracious Lacking social graces.

After Anna s kindness I wouldn t want to seem **ungracious**.

unthankful Not feeling or showing gratitude- Shakespeare.

No company ever went from them **unthankful**.

- He turned to the ungrateful task of forming a police cordon.
