## Synonyms of "Unhelpful" as an adjective (19 Words)

annoying	Causing irritation or annoyance. Tapping an <b>annoying</b> rhythm on his glass with his fork.
awkward	Deliberately unreasonable or uncooperative. An <b>awkward</b> dancer.
<u>contrary</u>	(of a wind) blowing in the opposite direction to one's course; unfavourable. <i>She is sulky and <b>contrary</b> where her work is concerned.</i>
difficult	Needing much effort or skill to accomplish, deal with, or understand. <i>Difficult</i> times.



<u>disobedient</u>	Not obeying or complying with commands of those in authority. <b>Disobedient</b> children.
disobliging	Deliberately unhelpful; uncooperative. I think you re simply being <b>disobliging</b> .
obstreperous	Boisterously and noisily aggressive. The boy is cocky and <b>obstreperous</b> .
obstructive	Preventing movement. The child developed severe <b>obstructive</b> symptoms.
<u>rebellious</u>	Engaged in opposition or armed resistance to an established government or leader. <i>The <b>rebellious</b> republics.</i>
recalcitrant	Marked by stubborn resistance to authority. The University suspended the most <b>recalcitrant</b> demonstrators.
refractory	Not responding to treatment. The <b>refractory</b> period of a muscle fiber.
<u>tiresome</u>	Causing one to feel bored or annoyed. The <b>tiresome</b> chirping of a cricket.
<u>troublesome</u>	Difficult to deal with. A <b>troublesome</b> infection.
unaccommodating	Offering no assistance. That harsh <b>unaccommodating</b> man had clearly loved his father.
<u>uncontrollable</u>	Of persons. Her brother had an <b>uncontrollable</b> temper.
uncooperative	Unwilling to cooperate. <i>The authorities were inclined to be <b>uncooperative</b>.</i>
unmanageable	Incapable of being controlled or managed. <i>His behaviour was becoming <b>unmanageable</b> at home.</i>
<u>unreasonable</u>	Not reasonable; not showing good judgment. <b>Unreasonable</b> demands.
<u>vexatious</u>	Causing irritation or annoyance. A <b>vexatious</b> child.
