disobliging Deliberately unhelpful; uncooperative.

I think you re simply being **disobliging**.

obstreperousBoisterously and noisily aggressive.

The boy is cocky and **obstreperous**.

obstructive Preventing movement.

The child developed severe **obstructive** symptoms.

Engaged in opposition or armed resistance to an established

<u>rebellious</u> government or leader.

The **rebellious** republics.

recalcitrant Marked by stubborn resistance to authority.

The University suspended the most recalcitrant demonstrators.

refractory Not responding to treatment.

The **refractory** period of a muscle fiber.

tiresome Causing one to feel bored or annoyed.

The **tiresome** chirping of a cricket.

troublesome Difficult to deal with.

A troublesome infection.

Offering no assistance.

unaccommodating That harsh unaccommodating man had clearly loved his father.

uncontrollable Of persons.

Her brother had an **uncontrollable** temper.

uncooperativeUnwilling to cooperate.

The authorities were inclined to be **uncooperative**.

unmanageable Incapable of being controlled or managed.

His behaviour was becoming **unmanageable** at home.

Not reasonable; not showing good judgment.

unreasonable
Unreasonable demands.

Causing irritation or annoyance.

vexatious

A vexatious child.
