Synonyms of "Unhelpful" as an adjective (19 Words)

annoying	Causing irritation or annoyance. <i>Tapping an annoying rhythm on his glass with his fork.</i>
awkward	Deliberately unreasonable or uncooperative. <i>An awkward dancer.</i>
contrary	(of a wind) blowing in the opposite direction to one's course; unfavourable. <i>She is sulky and contrary where her work is concerned.</i>
difficult	Needing much effort or skill to accomplish, deal with, or understand. <i>Difficult times.</i>

<u>disobedient</u>	Not obeying or complying with commands of those in authority. Disobedient children.
disobliging	Deliberately unhelpful; uncooperative. <i>I think you re simply being disobliging.</i>
obstreperous	Boisterously and noisily aggressive. <i>The boy is cocky and obstreperous.</i>
obstructive	Preventing movement. <i>The child developed severe obstructive symptoms.</i>
<u>rebellious</u>	Engaged in opposition or armed resistance to an established government or leader. <i>The rebellious republics.</i>
recalcitrant	Marked by stubborn resistance to authority. <i>The University suspended the most recalcitrant demonstrators.</i>
refractory	Not responding to treatment. <i>The refractory period of a muscle fiber.</i>
<u>tiresome</u>	Causing one to feel bored or annoyed. <i>The tiresome chirping of a cricket.</i>
<u>troublesome</u>	Difficult to deal with. <i>A troublesome infection.</i>
unaccommodating	Offering no assistance. <i>That harsh unaccommodating man had clearly loved his father.</i>
<u>uncontrollable</u>	Of persons. <i>Her brother had an uncontrollable temper.</i>
uncooperative	Unwilling to cooperate. <i>The authorities were inclined to be uncooperative.</i>
unmanageable	Incapable of being controlled or managed. <i>His behaviour was becoming unmanageable at home.</i>
<u>unreasonable</u>	Not reasonable; not showing good judgment. Unreasonable demands.
<u>vexatious</u>	Causing irritation or annoyance. <i>A vexatious child.</i>
